

MOUNTVIEW ROAD SCHOOL SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST: 2021 – 2022



ALL STUDENTS WILL NEED...



HEADPHONES:

All students need HEADPHONES. We will have them keep the headphones in their backpacks so they will have them for home and school. Please see below.

SANITIZING WIPES: We have supplies on hand, but any classroom donations of SANITIZING WIPES would be appreciated. A small hand sanitizer in the backpack and snack bag would be helpful also.

KINDERGARTEN – Items will need to be replaced, as needed

- ✓ (1) Backpack (without wheels)
- ✓ (1) Four-pack package of Elmer's glue sticks (0.77 ounce sticks)
- ✓ (1) Box of thin, black dry erase markers
- ✓ (2) Sterlite pencil cases (8 3/8" X 5 5/8 X 2 1/8)

GRADE 1 – Items will need to be replaced, as needed

- ✓ (1) BLUE Two-pocket folder (plastic so we can wipe off)
- ✓ #2 yellow pencils (one to two dozen) (no decorative pencils please)
- ✓ (3) Large, pink rubber erasers
- ✓ (1) Box of Crayons (16 count) Please do not send in large boxes of crayons.
- ✓ (1) Pair of scissors
- ✓ (1) Ten-pack of thin washable markers
- ✓ (3) yellow highlighters
- ✓ (10) Glue Sticks. Please do not send in any glue bottles.
- ✓ (1) box of thin, black EXPO dry erase markers

GRADE 2 – Items will need to be replaced, as needed

- ✓ (2) dozen sharpened #2 pencils
- ✓ (1) box of small crayons
- ✓ (2) large erasers
- ✓ (1) large zipped pencil case for daily supplies (approx. 6 x 10 in)
- ✓ (2) pens (red, blue, or black only)
- ✓ (2) yellow highlighters (no gel, please)
- ✓ (1) 10-pack broad line washable markers
- ✓ (1) 10-pack fine line washable markers
- ✓ (1) PACK of colored-pencils (12 or more)
- ✓ (4) dry erase markers (black, blue, red, or green only)
- ✓ (1) handheld pencil sharpener with shavings container (This will need to be replaced if it breaks, so we recommend choosing a quality brand that will last. We like the Fiskars brand.)
- ✓ (1) pair of scissors
- ✓ (5) large glue sticks
- ✓ (3) folders - On the front of the folder, please label one "Homework", one "Writing", and one "WIP".
- ✓ (1) 70 page, wide ruled spiral notebook
- ✓ (1) clear gallon-sized Ziploc bag to store extra supplies



Young children are sometimes prone to bathroom accidents. We recommend you pack at least one clean change of clothes (including underpants), labeled in a Ziploc bag, to keep in the bottom of the backpack.

GRADE 3 – Items will need to be replaced, as needed

- ✓ (1) double pocket homework folder
- ✓ (2) pencil cases (soft)
- ✓ Pencils (at least a dozen, sharpened)
- ✓ (2) dark colored pens
- ✓ (1) Highlighter
- ✓ thin-tip markers
- ✓ (1) pair of scissors (small/pointed)
- ✓ (6) large Elmer's glue sticks
- ✓ (1) Large pink rubber eraser
- ✓ (1) 1-inch 3 ring binder with a clear overlay (any color)

GRADE 4 – Items will need to be replaced, as needed

- ✓ (12) Pocket Expanding File Folder with Flap and Cord Closure letter-size. **Label the tabs with: Homework, Stay Home, Agenda, Grammar, Reading, Writing, TAPE/LA Ref., Spelling./Vocab., Reading Groups, Content, Math, Math Facts/WP**
- ✓ (1) two-pocket folder, free-choice design
- ✓ (2) spiral bound one-subject notebooks
- ✓ (2) soft pencil cases
- ✓ (4) jumbo book socks(dollar store has these if you purchase early)
- ✓ (2) packages 3x3 post-it notes
- ✓ (1) package index cards, either 3x5, 4x6, or 5x8
- ✓ (2) glue sticks
- ✓ (1) pair of scissors
- ✓ (2) highlighters
- ✓ (2) blue pens
- ✓ (2) red pens
- ✓ Colored pencils(no more than 40 in a package)
- ✓ (1) dozen sharpened pencils
- ✓ Erasers, as needed
- ✓ (1) BOX of black dry-erase markers

GRADE 5 – Items will need to be replaced, as needed

- ✓ (5) single-subject notebooks (green for science, blue for social studies, yellow for math, purple for study skills and red for ELA). This is for organization – try to match colors as close as possible.
- ✓ (5) double-pocket folders or accordion type file with pockets. Color-code the folders to match your notebooks. You will need one or the other – not both the folders and the file.
- ✓ Many #2 pencils, sharpened with erasers. These will need to be replenished as needed.
- ✓ (1) Zippered pencil case – not a plastic box – You will carry this from class to class with your tools inside.
- ✓ A few pens (blue or black) – You may want to have some erasable ink pens, too.
- ✓ (1) Dry Erase marker (any color) – this will need to be replenished as needed.
- ✓ (1) red pen
- ✓ (1) high-lighter
- ✓ (1) pair of scissors
- ✓ (1) white board eraser (can be a clean sock)
- ✓ (2) glue sticks (to be replenished as needed)

**PLEASE – NO 3-ring binders or Trappers.
There is not enough room in the fifth
grade desks to store them.**

With increasing technology and digital content being used with the students of Mountview Road School, the need to have a pair of comfortable headphones within reach for each child is a necessity.
