Dear Parents/Guardians:


I am pleased to inform you that the Alert Solutions notification system will once again be used as our primary means of contacting parents in the event of an emergency school closing. On Thursday, November 3rd, at 6:00 PM, an Alert Solutions "TEST" will be conducted via email, voice, and text messaging services. If you do not receive the Alert Solutions "TEST" message, please contact your child's respective school.

I would also like to remind you that there are several options available for receiving information regarding school emergencies that may help to keep you informed. Once the decision is made to close school, delay the opening of school, or institute an early dismissal, an "Alert Solutions" emergency message will be sent out via email, voice, and text messaging services. In addition, information is posted on the home page of our district website, www.hanovertwpschools.com, and a voice recording is left on the school district's main telephone number, (973) 515-2400.

I recently spoke with Tom Quirk, Director of the Office of Emergency Management for Hanover Township, who has indicated that parents may also receive information on emergency school closings through the "new" Everbridge notification system. To register for Everbridge, please go to the Hanover Township website, www.hanovertownship.com and click on the Everbridge link located in the right hand corner of the webpage. Once registered, you will receive information on emergency school closings, as well as other township advisories and community updates.

Thank you for your cooperation as we test our emergency notification system.
