Dear Parents/Guardians and Staff:

I hope this letter finds you and your family safe, healthy, and enjoying the Holiday weekend. This notification is to inform you that the district was notified earlier this afternoon that an individual from Bee Meadow School is considered “presumed” positive for COVID-19. Please be aware that because of health confidentiality laws, we cannot provide additional information.

Until further notice, and out of an abundance of caution, the Hanover Township Department of Health has recommended that Bee Meadow School “temporarily” pivot to a 100% remote learning model for ALL students beginning Tuesday, January 19, 2021. This will provide time for school personnel to collaboratively work with the Department of Health to complete all necessary contact tracing, which will continue throughout the coming days. Please note, all students and staff will follow the same daily schedule that has been in place. As this situation remains fluid, I will update you as necessary via our SwiftK12 notification system.

During this time, it is important for everyone to remember to complete the required Daily Student Screening via the rSchoolToday App and alert your school nurse immediately if your child exhibits symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or if you answer YES to any of the screening questions.
