Dear Parents/Guardians and Staff:

This letter is to inform you that the District was notified earlier today that an individual at Memorial Junior School has tested positive for COVID-19. In collaboration with the Hanover Township Department of Health, the district has completed contact tracing and has communicated directly with anyone who may have been exposed and has determined for this specific case, no additional action is required by the District. To be clear, at this time, if you have not been contacted by the school, you or your child was not impacted by this. Please be aware that because of health confidentiality laws, we cannot provide additional information.

In accordance with CDC, state and local health department guidelines, all individuals identified as “close” contacts will complete the required 14-day quarantine. A close contact is defined as someone who was within six (6) feet of a confirmed positive case for a cumulative total 15 minutes or more over a twenty-four hour period.

It is important for everyone to remember to complete the required Daily Student Screening via the rSchoolToday App and alert your school nurse immediately if your child exhibits symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or if you answer YES to any of the screening questions.
