

## Homework Policy

The district's homework policy states that 10 minutes of work, multiplied by the grade level is an appropriate amount of time that your child should be working on nightly assignments. Following this formula would put third graders at approximately 30 minutes of assigned work per night.

**Reading:** A monthly reading calendar is given to each student. They should be reading every night for 20 minutes. Students can read any type of book they choose or you may read aloud to them. The book(s) get logged onto the monthly calendar. You sign the calendar and your child returns it every Friday. These 20 minutes of reading are imperative for the development of your child's comprehension and critical thinking skills.

**Spelling:** On Monday, your child will have a list of the spelling words we are studying for the week. On Wednesday, they will have a list of vocabulary words. Both lists can be found in the spelling notebook. Spelling and vocabulary homework may be done in the notebook.

**Math:** Either the math homework book or a supplemental worksheet will be given nightly.

Monday: Math, Spelling, Reading

Wednesday: Math, Vocabulary,  
Reading

Tuesday: Math, Spelling, Reading

Thursday: Math, Spelling, Reading

\* Vocabulary, Grammar, Handwriting, Social Studies, and Science work may be assigned in place of or in addition to the above weekly assignments.
